A number of Asian artists are currently featured in exhibits at local galleries. Among them:

"Journey to the West on the Silk Road" in the Tzu Chi Foundation offices at 534 W. Belt Line Road in Richardson from Friday through March 17. The photo exhibit traces the route that Buddhist monk **Hsuan Tsang** took from China to India in the seventh century. A team of reporters and photographers spent five years traveling from Xian, China, into the Gobi Desert and central Asia to compile more than 150 photos for the exhibit, which has been shown internationally.
