Let's say your current tastes, not to mention your budget, lean toward art more influenced by caricature than de Kooning. All the more reason to enjoy a crisp November day by hitting the bricks and visiting some of the galleries in the Dallas Design District. Marty Walker's (2135 Farrington St. 214-749-0066) contemporary gallery is a good place to start. This month, Walker presents "Pacifica," an exhibit by Dallas-based artist Douglas Cartmel featuring oil paintings

on titanium and photographs inspired by the ocean. You'll feel calmer in the presence of his soothing works. In the smaller gallery, check out new creations by Laura Shipp. The ultimate recycler, she finds new uses for corporate, mass-produced paper products, coiling them into unique patterns.
