"Pard Morrison: Ghost Call Love" marks the debut of this Colorado artist at **Marty Walker Gallery**, which will showcase his work through Dec. 20. Mr. Morrison's brightly colored aluminum boxlike configurations function as both painting and sculpture in work that extols the virtues of minimalism and geometric abstraction. Mr. Morrison welds each canvas from aluminum sheets, and through a process called *patination* he bakes them over and over with colored layers. The finished product resembles what he calls glazed ceramic, with brushstrokes providing "the human touch." Mr. Morrison is based in Colorado Springs, Colo.
