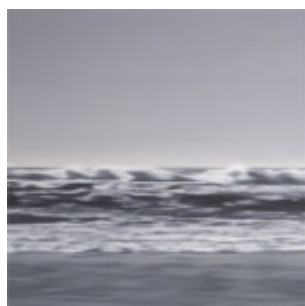

Marty Walker Gallery presents *SUPER NATURE*, an exhibition of new paintings by Dallas artist Douglas Leon Cartmel. "Cartmel's hauntingly subtle monochromatic paintings of slightly hazy reflections and foamy tides capture the fleeting natural abstractions of the ocean. Cartmel's sleek, refined seascapes share a sensibility with the work of Gerhard Richter for their detailed, realistic renderings taken from photographs that are quietly blurred by supple painterly brushstrokes." We couldn't have said it any better ourselves. Check out Cartmel's work in the exhibition *Coastlines* at the Dallas Museum of Art through August 22.

As if to announce that the Dallas Museum of Art doesn't have a monopoly on pining for the ocean with its "Coastlines" exhibition, Marty Walker Gallery brings us Douglas Leon Cartmel's "Super Nature," whose paintings, in the words of the organizers, "capture the fleeting natural abstractions" of the sea with a sensibility reminiscent of Gerhard Richter.

Dallas artist Douglas Leon Cartmel's latest exhibition is called *Super Nature*, an appropriate title when you see the beauty of his paintings. Cartmel's works are "detailed, realistic renderings taken from photographs that are quietly blurred by supple painterly brushstrokes," according to the press release. The result is a mesmerizing black-and-white picture that is impossible to take your eyes off.
